



Brief History of TNSU



1970

- Department of Physical Education, Ministry of Education, had the policy to produce physical education teachers for all regions of Thailand.
- The first physical education college “College of Physical Education Chiang Mai” was established.
- The other colleges were built continuously until there were seventeen colleges of physical education to provide the higher vocational certificate (physical education).

2002

- By the laws, Department of Physical Education was transferred to be under Ministry of Tourism and Sports and its name was changed into “Office of Sports and Recreation Development.”
- All colleges of physical education and sports schools were transferred to be under the Office of Sports and Recreation Development, Ministry of Tourism and Sports.



1991

- The Department of Physical Education had the idea to enhance sports in Thailand by starting from the development of students in the basic education.
- The first sports school “Suphan Buri Sports School” was set up in Thailand.
- The thirteen sports schools under College of Physical Education were founded to educate the students with sports talents.



Brief History of TNSU



2005

- College of Physical Education was upgraded and its name was changed into “**Institute of Physical Education**” under the Ministry of Tourism and Sports due to the **Institute of Physical Education Act B.E. 2548**.
- It was able to produce the bachelor’s degree students.



2019

- The status of Institute of Physical Education was uplifted to become “**Thailand National Sports University**” by the **Thailand National Sports University Act B.E. 2562**.
- It became effective on 23 May 2019.



- The **Second Institute of Physical Education Act B.E. 2555** was enacted.
- It was able to provide the education in the master’s and doctoral degrees.
